TIME FOR ACTION

Please register your objection.

Sadberge Parish Council asks all Sadberge residents to register objections to the proposed Moor House Wind Farm.

In order of likely impact, the options are:

- (1) Write your own letter of objection in your own words.
- (2) Use the facility on the Sadberge web site (www.sadberge.org.uk) to generate a customised objection letter.
- (3) Use the standard objection letter enclosed with this flyer.

You can post your letter directly to Adrian Hobbs. Alternatively, you can hand it in to the Coffee Shop in the village hall or give it to Alastair Mackenzie (Mayfield House, Middleton Road) and we will ensure that it is delivered.

If you are using the standard objection letter then please ensure that you:-

- fill in your address and the date in the top right hand corner, and
- get all the relevant people to sign and print their name(s) at the bottom.

Sadberge Parish Council hopes that all residents will support our community's position on this issue, as set out in the Wind Farms Addendum to the Sadberge Parish Plan.

Please bear in mind that more than three quarters of the Sadberge residents who responded to the Wind Farms Questionnaire said that we should oppose wind farms in this area.

If, for whatever reason, you do not wish to object to the Moor House Wind Farm planning application then please at least write to Darlington Borough Council asking for any planning permission to be accompanied by strict, legally binding planning conditions to minimise the harm to local residents. In particular, please insist that:-

- There should be effective planning conditions dealing with noise, including aerodynamic modulation. (ETSU-R-97 does not provide effective protection against aerodynamic modulation.)
- No permission should be granted until and unless Durham Tees Valley Airport makes a formal, public statement that aircraft safety will not be compromised.
